

RULES FOR PLAYERS AT CHARITY EVENTS

Windy City Poker Championship works with multiple local charities to host player and family friendly events that bring all types of players and people together to play poker for fun while still competing for great prizes pools all while helping raise money for local charities and groups.

The events will feature cash games and tournaments and have a format similar to hosting casino. So this means rules are the same for players at the events that they would get at casino locations, poker rooms, or other restaurants.

Players are not allowed to solicit or recruit for other events or home games, players are also not allowed to sell or distribute any materials or product or merchandise without approval from hosting charities or Windy City Poker Championship.

All payouts will adhere to posted rules and requirements for charitable gaming events and must be followed by the player.

Player conduct must also be considered for the best experience of those participating. Those who get out of line or are asked to leave may not be allowed back pending the decision of Windy City Poker Championship, Host locations, and hosting charities.

If a player is determined to be needed to be removed from the event they will forfeit any tournament chips and not receive a refund, or their cash game chips will be cashed out and funds will be given to the player. If that player is not welcomed back or banned from future events where they are eligible to participate or have a seat into then they forfeit that seat as well just like at any hosting casino.

Those who are asked to leave may petition to be able to return to host locations or events through Windy City Poker Championship but will be decided on by a case by case basis. A player who is removed from any event is automatically banned from future events and must petition to return. This is non negotiable and the person may or may not be informed in writing or verbally of their inability to play in the events.

Player rules as of January 1st, 2020
